VETERINARY IMPORT PERMIT FOR HORSES

The Veterinary Authority hereby permits.....

the undermentioned:

This permit is granted subject to the terms and conditions relating to the importation of the above mentioned set out in the regulations for the time being in force and to the following terms and conditions:-

1. To be accompanied by a health certificate from the Veterinary Authority of the exporting country stating:-
 - (a) the country from which the horse is exported has been free of foot and Mouth Disease for a period of at least twelve months, immediately prior to the date of the exportation of the horse; and
 - (b) the horse is in good health and free from any symptoms of any prescribed or any other infectious or contagious disease; and
 - (c) the horse has been subjected to the Coggins* Test for Equine Infectious Anaemia, with negative reactions, within the sixty days immediately prior to the date of its exportation; and
 - (d) in so far as it has been possible to ascertain no case of Dourine (*Mal de Coit*), *Mal de Caderas*, Glanders (*Farcy*), Epizootic Lymphangitis, Ulcerative Lymphangitis, Equine Influenza, Equine Infectious Anaemia, African Horse Sickness, Vesicular Stomatitis, Equine Encephalomyelitis or Mange has occurred on the premises from which the horse originated, or at any place within fifteen miles therefrom, during the sixty days immediately prior to the date of its exportation.

2. Inspection on arrival at the port of entry.
