VETERINARY IMPORT PERMIT FOR SWINE

This permit is granted subject to the terms and conditions relating to the importation of the above mentioned set out in the regulations for the time being in force and to the following terms and conditions:-

1. To be accompanied by a health certificate from the Veterinary Authority of the exporting country stating:-
 - (a) the country from which the pig is exported has been free from Foot and Mouth Disease Vesicular Stomatitis, Swine fever, African Swine Fever and, Swine Vesicular disease for a period of at least twenty-four months immediately prior to the date of the exportation of the pig and;
 - (b) the pig is physically sound and in good health and free from symptoms of Virus Pneumonia, Vesicular Exanthema, Atrophic Rhinitis and all other prescribed infectious or contagious disease; and
 - (c) where the pig is exported from a country which is enzootically infected with Erysipelas or Brucellosis, the pig, during the three months immediately prior to exportation, has been vaccinated against erysipelas or as the case may be, has been subjected with negative reactions, to the serum agglutination test, with internationally approved antigens, for Brucellosis
2. Inspection on arrival at the port of entry.
