The particulars are as follows:

Date: 27<sup>th</sup> to 31<sup>st</sup> October 2025

**Duration**: 9:00 am to 12:00 pm

Fee: \$ 150.00 per participant

**Location**: H. S. Hanley Training Room – Customs Headquarters – Bird Rock

Expectations: Applicants must bring their own device (computer/ laptop)

Applicants must have an ASYCUDA World System [AWS] account

Applicants must know the fundamentals [calculating CIF, finding H.S. Code,

etc.]

Be punctual [the sessions will start **ON-TIME**]

**Key**: How to log in to and navigate the **ASYCUDA** World System

How to create a declaration [single and multiple lines]

How to attach scanned documents

How to add a container, document, etc.

How to save, retrieve and submit declarations

How to address queried declarations
