Item 1: COMET Power and AJAX Powder



The items are powdered deodorizing cleansers with Chlorinol. They contain 60-100% calcium carbonate. Other ingredients are listed as:

- Calcium Carbonate - Scrubbing Agent
- Calcium Hydroxide - pH Adjuster
- Fragrance
- Green 7 - Colorant (except in Comet Lemon Powder)
- Sodium Carbonate - Builder/Sequestering Agent
- Sodium Linear Alkylbenzenesulfonate Surfactant - Cleaning Agent
- Trichloro-s-triazinetrione – Bleach

Classifications Considered

The HS Codes that were considered are 3402.90.90 and 3405.40.00

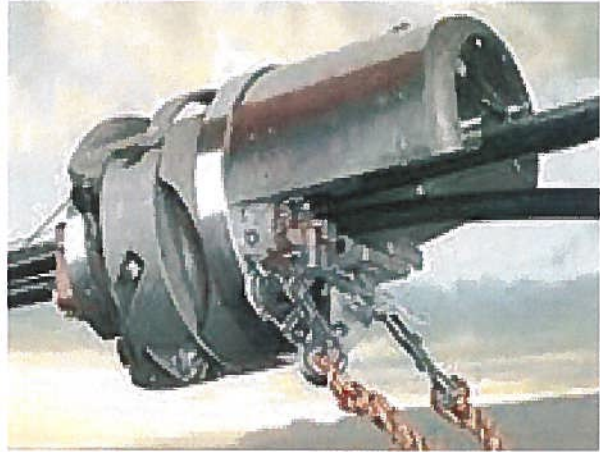
Ruling: H.S. 3405.40.00

Based on the application of the General Rules of Interpretation - Rule 1. The Harmonised System (H.S.) Chapter 34 Note 2 which states:

"... Products containing abrasive powders remain classified in heading 3401. Only if in the form of bars,

cakes or moulded pieces or shapes. In other forms they are to be classified in heading 3405 as “scouring powders and similar preparations.”

Item 2: J2 Cable Lasher



A device that lashes a single aerial cable or numerous cables to a supporting strand or to an existing lashed cable with a stainless lashing wire. The device is not self-propelled but relies on an external force to move along the main cable.

Classifications Considered

The HS Coded that were considered are 8479.89.40 and 8479.89.00

Ruling: H.S. 8479.40.00

Based on the application of the General Rules of Interpretation – Rule 1 and 4, the General Explanatory Notes to the Harmonised System (H.S.) 2007 for the Heading **8479** and also in consultation with C.C.L.E.C. Member Authorities.

Item 3: Domestic Clothes Dryers:



A household appliance that is used to remove moisture from a load of clothing and other textiles usually shortly after they are washed in a washing machine. Many dryers consist of a rotating drum called a "tumbler" through which heated air is circulated to evaporate the moisture, while the tumbler is rotated to maintain air space between the articles.

Classifications Considered

The H.S. Codes that were considered 8421.12.10 and 8451.21.00.

Ruling: H. S. 8451.29.00

Based on the application of General Rules of Interpretation- Rule 1.
